**"Chestnut Hunting"** Chestnut trees will begin to bloom in Kentucky from mid- June to early July. Be on the look-out for wild type Americans in your woods. A few surviving stump sprouts live long enough to begin to bloom. However, few produce viable nuts because of the trees need to cross pollinate. **If you find what you believe to be a surviving American chestnut you can report its location by using a form found at [www.acf.org](http://www.acf.org). Or simply use the Tree Snap App to record the tree and its location.** Col. Jimmie Sizemore, KWOA Director and American Chestnut Foundation volunteer, provided this pictures below to help you search. 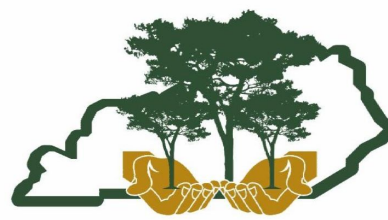
